#### 6 REPORTS

## 5.1 Consideration of 10 March 2025 Applications

Community Partnerships Co-ordinator, Ms Panfylova's report was taken as read.

There was a discussion of how much funding is actually available. Ms Panfylova noted that previous report was incorrect and the actual amount available for the rest of this financial year is \$44,506.

Ms Panfylova noted that there is no need to hold any funds for promotion as this is the last round for the year.

All applications meet the criteria but Multicultural Nelson have since withdrawn their application so it will not be considered in this funding round.

The Subcommittee discussed the applications for this round and allocated the following amounts to the Creative Communities Fund:

## Cathy Irons - Douce Ambiance

The Subcommittee considered the amount of \$500 was appropriate.

## Circus Susurrus - Sensory Circus Show

The Subcommittee declined this application as it was a lower priority. The Subcommittee suggested they re-apply to the next round with an explicit budget and list of all contributions.

#### Craig Denham - Singalong Mondays at The Mussel Inn

The Subcommittee declined this application as it was a lower priority.

#### Donna McLeod - Hikoi Awhiowhio - 19 April to 4 May

The Subcommittee considered the amount of \$2,000 was appropriate.

#### Donna McLeod - Renee Kahukura, Osefa Nga Pae Rewa pu Korero

The Subcommittee considered the amount of \$2,000 was appropriate.

#### Golden Bay Community Arts Council - Bay Art 2024 and Young@Art 2025

The Subcommittee considered the amount of \$2,500 was appropriate. The Subcommittee noted that this allocation cannot be used for prizes.

## Golden Bay Workcentre Trust - community adult art and craft classes

The Subcommittee considered the amount of \$2,000 was appropriate.

#### Jodie Nakat - The Hula Hoop and Bubble Show

The Subcommittee declined this application as it was a lower priority. The Subcommittee recommended they reapply with letters from the schools confirming they will support the project.

## Lyndal Brunt - Clay workshops for all ages to learn about making pottery

The Subcommittee declined this application as it was a lower priority. The Subcommittee recommend that they reapply to the next round after discussion with staff and clarification of the workshop project.

## Mapua Community Library - Māpua Community Library Literary Festival

The Subcommittee considered the amount of \$1,273 was appropriate.

## Ministry of Inspiration - Pixel Light-shifting shapes and moving colours

The Subcommittee declined this application as it was ineligible. The Subcommittee recommended that a new application be submitted and that it includes support letters from schools.

## Ministry of Inspiration - Robocup Jr Theatre Edition

The Subcommittee considered the amount of \$1,000 was appropriate.

#### Motueka High School - Rangitahi Haumaru Services

The Subcommittee declined this applications as it was ineligible. The Subcommittee suggested they reapply in the next round for just the design and screen printing part of the project.

#### Multicultural Nelson Tasman Multicultural - Welcome Mural in Motueka

This application was withdrawn prior to the meeting as the event has been postponed.

## **Ngatimoti School - Ngatimoti Road Safety Signs**

The Subcommittee considered the amount of \$500 was appropriate.

#### **Tasman National Art Awards - Tasman National Art Awards**

The Subcommittee considered the amount of \$1,000 was appropriate.

#### Te Ataarangi ki Te Tauihu o Te Waka-a-Maui - community art Wananga

The Subcommittee considered the amount of \$2,000 was appropriate.

#### Te Mana Hā - Waiata Workshop

The Subcommittee considered the amount of \$645 was appropriate.

## Tell Tales Collective - Playback Theatre for Community Groups

The Subcommittee declined this application as it was a lower priority. The Subcommittee suggested they reapply with clarification around the arts/performance part of the project.

#### Tokomaru Research Centre - Te Heke Whakanga - Ngati Tarua exhibition

The Subcommittee considered the amount of \$2,000 was appropriate. The Subcommittee recommends this group also apply to Tasman District Council's Community Grants Funding.

## Toy Murchie - 35 years at the Museum: Artists Impressions

The Subcommittee considered the amount of \$1,405 was appropriate.
