7.2 Motueka Master Plan

Environmental Policy Manager, Barry Johnson and Team Leader – Natural Resources, Diana Worthy, presented the report.

- Clause 4 the removal of 'approved' and 'by the new Council in 2026'
- Clause 5 was added

That the Strategy and Policy Committee

- 1. receives the Motueka Master Plan report RSPC25-05-2; and
- 2. approves commencement of background work on the Motueka Master Plan, including project management, the gathering of background information and information to inform decisions on the scope, budget and timing of the Motueka Master Plan project; and
- 3. notes background work on the Motueka Master Plan to inform decisions on the scope and timing of the project will occur; and
- 4. acknowledges that the final work programme, project scope, budget, timing and governance arrangements for the Motueka Master Plan project will be brought back to Council prior to October; and
- 5. agrees that a report be brought back to the full Tasman District Council for a decision on the scope of the Motueka Master Plan by the end of July 2025.

7.3 Notification of the draft Richmond Ward Reserve Management Plan

- 4. agrees to the Mayor and the Group Manager Community Infrastructure being delegated the ability to sign off any further minor editorial amendments to the Draft Richmond Ward Reserve Management Plan before public notification; and
- 5. delegates the task of hearing and deliberating on submissions received on both the Draft Richmond Ward Reserve Management Plan, and making recommendations on amendments to the document, to a Richmond Ward Reserve Management Plan Hearing Panel; and
- 6. appoints a Richmond Ward Reserve Management Plan Hearing Panel consisting of three or four councillors:

Councillor Mark Greening and,

Councillor Kit Maling and,

if available, up to two Matauranga Māori experts [to be appointed by the Mayor], with the Richmond Ward Reserve Management Plan Hearing Panel Chairperson having the ability to appoint another councillor should an appointed member of the panel be unavailable; and

7. agrees that the Richmond Ward Reserve Management Plan Hearing Panel will report back to the Council on 25 September 2025 with recommendations on amendments to the Draft Richmond Ward Reserve Management Plan, for a decision on whether to adopt the final document.

- 4. delegates to the Waimea River Park Management Plan Hearing Panel Chair and the Group Manager Environmental Science the ability to sign off any further minor amendments to the Draft Waimea River Park Management Plan before issuing for public consultation; and
- 5. agrees that the Waimea River Park Management Plan will be amended by staff, as per the Waimea River Park Management Plan Hearing Panel recommendations following deliberations and presented to the Strategy and Policy Committee on 18 September 2025 for a decision on whether to adopt the Final Waimea River Park Management Plan.
