5.1 Consideration of 10 July 2025 Applications

Community Partnerships Co-ordinator, Ms Panfylova report was taken as read.

The Subcommittee discussed the applications and allocated the following amounts to the Creative Communities Fund:

Chroma Chamber Choir - Christmas Cheer Concert

The Subcommittee considered the amount of \$650 was appropriate. The Subcommittee asked that they consider a venue in Motueka in the future and noted that the projected audience numbers appeared to be on the conservative side.

Claire Stanley - Sing 2025

The Subcommittee declined this application as it was a lower priority.

DramaLAB - Ministry of Connection (worktitle)

The Subcommittee considered the amount of \$1,000 was appropriate.

Fresh FM (T/A The Tasman Broadcasting Trust) - Youth Workshops

The Subcommittee considered the amount of \$1,000 was appropriate.

Golden Bay Community Arts Council - Summer Arts Festival

Komitimiti Music Group - Family Art and Craft Space
