#### 3. Motueka Historical Wharf Restoration Update

- 3.1 The Heritage Wharf Group has just been awarded a grant of \$150,000 from the Lotteries Environment & Heritage Fund, towards the restoration of the Heritage Wharf. While it is not as much as the Group requested (\$210,000), it is enough to give confidence that the project is do-able. It means they have now raised over \$289,000 towards the estimated cost of \$378,000 for the main part of the project work.  
Fundraising is ongoing.
- 3.2 Last year Council requested a business case be prepared for the wharf restoration, including investigating cost-saving options. That business case is being finalised and will be submitted in April 2026. It is expected to include a request for a capital contribution from Council of \$60,000, which is the amount of the shortfall of the Lotteries Grant.
